

# ADRA Timor-Leste Program Strategy 2016-2021

# BACKGROUND

Since 2010, ADRA Timor-Leste has been implementing community development programs in Viqueque Municipality. In partnership with the Ministry of Public Works, *Serviço De Águas e Saneamento* (SAS), and the Ministry of Health, ADRA TL's support began with providing access to clean water, as well as sanitation and hygiene promotion. ADRA TL has also implemented school refurbishment and tobacco awareness projects. Building on the experience and relationships developed with community members and local leaders in Viqueque, ADRA TL, in coordination with the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries, expanded its support to agriculture livelihoods through nutrition-sensitive horticulture and conservation agriculture activities. Past projects have been supported by funds from Australian Aid, ADRA International and ADRA network offices in Australia, Portugal and New Zealand. ADRA TL is committed to inclusive, participatory community development and supporting the government of Timor-Leste in achieving its goals articulated in its Strategic Development Plan 2011-2030.

## OUR ROLE IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF TIMOR-LESTE

We are committed to working in underserved areas of Timor-Leste focusing on vulnerable communities in Viqueque Municipality. For the next three years (2016-2019) we plan to continue integrated programming in Lacluta and Viqueque administrative posts where ADRA TL has established positive working relationships. The following phase will seek to expand programs to other high needs *sukos* in Viqueque Municipality.
