

To strengthen CSOs to operate effectively to support development and women's empowerment.

SO2

To promote supportive relationships within families for participation in society and economic activities.

SO3

To support women's engagement in society and the economy through participation in value chains and market systems.

Target Groups

- ◆ SO1 45 CSOs, part of a CSO network and their CSO members. Selected will be Local CSOs whose mission is to promote women's empowerment.
- SO2 46,849 actual households for gender awareness/inclusion activity, equal to 234,242 people (total members of households). Selection criteria is families living in urban (Dili Municipality) or rural areas (Ainaro, Baucau, Bobonaro Municipalities).
- ◆ SO3 216 female head of households for production, processing, trading, and saving and loan activities), representing 1.144 people (total members households). 60 Informal groups active in production, processing, trading, saving and loan activities, consisting of 1,784 members and non-members equal 10,600 members of households benefitting.
